3 DAY ITINERARY

DAY ONE

A Flight to Remember Wake early on your opening day in Christchurch for a majestic hot air balloon or helicopter ride over Canterbury. Flights depart in time for you to watch the morning sun roll in over the plains. Once you are back on solid ground enjoy a celebratory glass of chilled bubbly.

Classic Country Charm Depart mid morning for Terrace Downs High Country Resort. Enjoy a gourmet BBQ lunch while overlooking the stunning foothills of the Southern Alps before playing a round of golf on the resort's championship course. If golf is not for you, there are plenty of other activities to keep you occupied. Try your hand at clay pigeon shooting, archery, go salmon or trout fishing, take a horse trek or indulge in a spa treatment at The Spa. DAY TWO

Rolling Plains and Highland Lakes Spend the morning on a coach. Ride through the Canterbury plains, passing the mirror-like lakes of the MacKenzie High Country and the iconic Church of the Good Shepherd on the shores of Lake Tekapo. Stop for lunch at Peppers Blue water Resort before taking a relaxing soak in the hot pools overlooking the Lake. Travel by coach or chartered plane to the renowned Hermitage Hotel at Mount Cook village at the base of Aoraki Mount Cook, New Zealand's tallest mountain.


Cosy Luxury or Alpine Adventure Whether you're up for adventure or simply want to cosy down by the fire, all travellers are catered for at the Hermitage. Afternoon activities include alpine 4WD tours, fly fishing, mountain hikes or flight seeing over the nearby glaciers. At night, the clear mountain air is perfect for stargazing at the southern skies.

DAY THREE

The Phenomenal Tasman Glacier Take a boat tour with Glacier Explorers to observe the Tasman Glacier up close in its transition from towering ice cliffs to lake. The glacier's floating icebergs are always on the move and the boat passes so close you can almost touch them.

A Fond Farewell Bid farewell to the Hermitage with lunch and a visit to the Sir Edmund Hillary Alpine Centre and Museum, then return to the Garden city to experience your choice of evening entertainment. Before you take your leave, you will have the opportunity to go out and experience the nightlife, Christchurch's culinary delights, or take some recovery time back at the hotel.


