
## 3 DAY ITINERARY

### DAY ONE

**Get a Bird's Eye View** Start your time in Wellington with a helicopter tour over the city and rugged south coast. Conclude your flight with lunch at the exclusive Boomrock Lodge or award winning Wharekauhau Country Estate.


### DAY THREE

**Savour Wairarapa's Wines** Wake early for a transfer to the nearby Wairarapa wine region, famous for its boutique wineries. Meet the vintners and enjoy some of the world's best wines as you make your way around some of the award-winning wineries surrounding the settlement of Martinborough — the Wairarapa's wine hub.
